Week 1-Lesson 1, Autumn Term	<i>Introduction to Flower Making</i>  Show a brief video about making flowers and introduced to the artist Lia Griffith.  Make a trial paper flower for them to practice.	Crepe Paper Flower book by Lia Griffith. Templates p.173  YouTube clips from Lia Griffith on how to use the templates and how to correctly cut them. <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0YfKulM5tjM">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0YfKulM5tjM</a>  Pupils can choose different sizes to make their flowers.  Print flower templates and instructions on how to make the flower.  By 7/11 pupils can choose what flower they want to do in the next lesson.	Research skills. Research about Lia Griffith and familiarise with her work.  Observation skills, design skills and planning skills.	Differentiated research assignment write-up worksheet.  Students with slow processing speed in reading can access video clips with step by step instructions.
Week 1- Lesson 2, Autumn Term	Pupils should have chosen their next flower by this lesson and they will attempt to make it. For example: Peony flower	Step by step instructions on how to make Peony flower. P98-99.  Homework: To make a flower/ Instruction sheet will be given on the day to take home. This flower needs to be done before our next lesson 11/11	Learn the different techniques used making the flowers.	Gifted & Talented extension task: Make 2 or more flowers by choosing their own.  Students who find it difficult to follow instructions videos will be available.
Week 2- Lesson 3, Autumn Term	Pupils can continue working on their paper flowers from last weeks. Add last details such as paint/glitter.	Step by step instructions.  Homework: Write up a small paragraph about what have they learnt from the workshop.	Reflection on their work.	Gifted & talented extension task: Make their own set of flowers and create a bouquet or pots/vase.
Week 2- Lesson 4, Autumn Term	Mop up lesson – Presentation of their work	Opportunity to complete any unfinished work, take photographs for their portfolios.	Communication skills. Sharing feedback on the lesson.	Gifted & talented extension task: Create a power point about what they have learnt and photograph their work.
